To whom it may concern:

The Tucson Military Vehicle Museum is opening to the public tomorrow, Friday, March 21, 2025. This brand-new museum is unlike anything else in the region and even in most of the country. Visitors will learn about the historical role of these land-dominating military assets while getting up close to the real thing. You will even be able to touch many of the exhibits.

The collection is opening with over 60 military vehicles on display including tanks, armored personnel carriers, amphibious assault vehicles, artillery and more. We will continue to put more on display and grow the collection through new acquisitions. The museum will also eventually have demonstrations and a program for riding and driving experiences.

A large portion of the collection, 21 beautifully restored U.S. and British WWII vehicles, comes from the personal collection of the late Count Ferdinand von Galen, former Chairman of the Board. It was donated by his family in memoriam, as was his wish. The National Museums of the U.S. Marine Corps, U.S. Army, and others have loaned the Foundation vehicles for display making for an inclusive collection of modern, vintage, domestic, and international examples. The U.S. General Services Administration has also been beneficial with assistance in procuring vehicles.

The breathtaking new facility is located on the same property as Pima Air & Space Museum, 6000 E Valencia Rd. Tucson, AZ 85756. It is operated by the same non-profit, the Arizona Aerospace Foundation. Tickets to the two museums will be sold separately. The Foundation also operates the Titan Missile Museum in Green Valley, Arizona. The addition of the new Tucson Military Vehicle Museum brings the story of military systems further to life covering the relationship between preventative measures with air and ground forces.

Outside of special events and holidays, we will be open 7 days a week, 9am-5pm, and last admission at 3pm. Summer hours vary. Our website will contain more information regarding hours of operation and ticket pricing. There is a gift store and grab-and-go style food and beverages on site.
